# Run, Paloma, run

We know it's a primary. We're not taking sides. But an 18-year-old woman running for the Ohio House District 2 state senate seat jumped off her campaign this week in the Register, making her clear differences with the incumbent known upfront.

Paloma De La Fuente, a Perrysburg resident, graduated from high school in Perrysburg. She took a gap semester and will begin school in the spring at the University of Toledo, majoring in legal and paralegal studies. She plans to attend law school. But, for now, she's the candidate who wants to run against incumbent Theresa Gavarone in the fall. "This is my job now," De La Fuente told Register reporter Tom Jackson. We cannot think of anything better for a fresh perspective than for young people being involved in our electoral process from a young age. She's pro-reproductive rights, pro-environment, the economy and labor and pro-education, she said.
